#### Characteristics:

Cemenrapid is an all-purpose mortar with rapid setting. Made of cements and selected grain size aggregates, able to develop high resistance properties, it can be used in indoor and outdoor civil, commercial and industrial applications.

#### Preparation:

The base must be sound, compact, have no parts coming away, and be free of dust, grease, oil, paint, and wax. Carefully wet the area to be treated and, using water, cool any surfaces that have heated up through exposure to sunlight.

#### Quality and Environmental Standards:

Cemenrapid undergoes constant, careful testing at our laboratories, in compliance with the legislation in force-UNI EN ISO 9001/2015.

#### Application:

Mix Cemenrapid with clean water, to obtain a smooth, lump-free paste. Do not add other aggregates or hydraulic binders to Cemenrapid. If the mixture is already hardening, do not attempt to restore workability by adding water.Mix small amounts of the product, which must be used very quickly as it begins to set just two or three minute after mixing. During water, we recommend you use water with a temperature of + 20°C. In warmer periods and hotter temperatures, use very cold water for mixing. These techniques will ensure the setting time remains within prescribed standards. The mixture should be applied with a standard trowel. Elements of a considerable weight, such assecondary frames, gates, etc., must be held in place for a few hours.
